


Linking micro and macro (Hall and Soskice 2001)

- "Coordinated market economies"—e.g., Germany
 - Stakeholder model
 - Longer-term bargains among workers, managers, owners
 - More extensive worker control mechanisms, including unions
- "Liberal market economies"—e.g., the United States
 - Shareholder model
 - Shorter-term interactions among workers, managers, owners
 - More extensive employee ownership arrangements




